THE 2ND CALL FOR PROPOSALS IS LAUNCHED!

By the decision of the JMC of the Programme the 2nd Call for Proposals was announced on the 1st of February, 2019 and shall be closed on the 17th of April, 2019!

Programme funding for any project under Priorities 1.1., 2.1. and 3.1. may be requested from 100 000 EUR to 1 million EUR. The maximum Programme funding for a project under the Priority 4.1. has been significantly increased up to 2 million EUR.

Project proposals are to be received by the JTS in Vilnius till the 17th of April, 2019, 14:00 (Vilnius time) at the latest!

The JTS in cooperation with the specialists from the Branch Office in Kaliningrad carried out 2 information events for potential applicants of the 2nd Call for Proposals in Kaliningrad and Raseiniai in February, 2019.

More than 80 participants in Kaliningrad and 50 participants in Raseiniai were introduced with the main Programme requirements and rules, common shortcomings of the project proposals submitted during the 1st Call for Proposals and were able to ask the most important questions during the Questions & Answers session held.
